The American homefront was impacted in several key areas by the Cold War. Politically: Perhaps most famously, Americans strongly connected with the idea of a distant and ideologically foreign enemy.

How did the Cold War affect the American homefront?

The Cold War: The Atomic Age. Thus began a deadly "arms race." In 1949, the Soviets tested an atom bomb of their own. In response, President Truman announced that the United States would build an even more destructive atomic weapon: the hydrogen bomb, or "superbomb." Stalin

followed suit.
