It was the second conflict in which military action was precipitated by media involvement. The war grew out of U.S. interest in a fight for revolution between the Spanish military and citizens of their Cuban colony.

On February 15, 1898, the U.S. battleship Maine, patrolling in the Havana harbor, suffered a massive explosion. The ship was lost along with 260 crewman. The incident destroyed relations between Spain and the U.S. and catalyzed the Spanish-American War, though no proof has ever emerged that Spain was involved.
